

# Terms & Conditions – The Startup Kids

## **1. Introduction**

These Terms & Conditions apply to all workshops and programmes delivered by The Startup Kids. By registering your child for a session, you agree to the terms outlined below.

## **2. Eligibility**

Workshops are designed for young people aged 10–16. By registering, you confirm that your child falls within this age group or that you have discussed suitability with us in advance.

---

## **3. Registration & Booking**

Places are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Submission of a registration form or expression of interest does not guarantee a confirmed place until you receive confirmation from us.

---

## **4. Minimum Group Size**

Workshops require a minimum number of participants to run. If a session does not reach the required number, we reserve the right to:

- reschedule the session
  - offer an alternative date
  - or provide a suitable alternative option
- 

## **5. Payments**

Where applicable, full payment must be made in advance to secure a place. Payment details will be provided upon confirmation of the session.

## **6. Cancellations & Refunds**

### **By Parents/Guardians:**

- Cancellations made at least 48 hours before the session may be eligible for a refund or transfer to a future session.
- Cancellations made within 48 hours of the session may not be eligible for a refund.

### **By The Startup Kids:**

If we need to cancel or reschedule a session, you will be offered:

- a full refund, or
  - a place in a future session
- 

## **7. Behaviour & Participation**

We aim to provide a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment.

If a participant's behaviour is disruptive or unsafe, we reserve the right to remove them from the session. In such cases, refunds may not be provided.
